“Funding Central” is an online resource to enable third sector groups to identify funding and grant sources suitable to their needs and objectives. This short, hands-on workshop will help you find your way around this tool effectively.

Since early 2008, VANEL has provided North East Lincolnshire based Third Sector Organisations with free access to the **GRANTnet** online grant finding service through our **Third Sector Hub** programme.

From 2010 this service will no longer be available via VANEL, but all third sector organisations are now able to make use of the national, NCVO & Cabinet Office supported “Funding Central” website – www.fundingcentral.org.uk.

If you're unfamiliar with the website, need advice and guidance on using it and using it effectively, then we've organised free hands-on sessions to help to get to grips with this new service.

The sessions are delivered by **Helen Howard**, Funding Advice Development Worker at VANEL who is part of the **Fundraising Plus** project.
