Submitting an application for funding or for a grant is never straightforward, often time-consuming but usually a critical task for a third sector organisation looking to continue or expand its good work. This workshop sets out to help participants make that effort count by putting forward effective applications.

Participants will learn about what funders are looking for, how to complete an application effectively, some tips for successful applications and how to assess applications (your own or others).

This will be a practical session working through real examples to ensure you get the most learning possible from the day. If you've never submitted an application, perhaps have failed on an application previously or would just benefit from learning more about making your applications more effective, then this workshop is for you.
